sharing — and isn't that one of life's joys?" Michael adds, "Sholom is such a vital extension of the uniquely caring and giving environment that is in the Twin Cities Jewish community. We saw instantly why this was not only a perfectly fitting gift to the community, but also a celebration of our parents' wonderfully generous spirit."

Leo says, "We're very fortunate to have Sholom in Minneapolis with housing for the well elderly, for those who need assisted living and for those who need nursing home care — and soon St. Paul will have new Sholom facilities too." Helen adds, "We feel that it's very important for all of us who are Jewish to support our Jewish organizations and community facilities."

A Belief in Helping All

The Wolks firmly believe that giving is essential to a full life — and not only to Jewish causes. Involved in countless Jewish groups such as the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW), Jewish Family & Children's Service, Jewish Community Center, Temple Israel, Minneapolis Jewish Federation, and the Jewish Historical Society of the Upper Midwest; Helen and Leo have also supported the Minneapolis Institute of Arts, Minnesota Historical Society, Minneapolis Foundation, University of Minnesota (members of the Builders Society of the President's Club), and the city of Burnsville to which they gave 50 acres of land for a park.

Both say their attitude toward giving came from others. Leo, always ready with a keen sense of humor, credits Helen. "When we were first married we didn't have much money, but she always managed to find some to give away." Helen credits her mother, an active NCJW member, for instilling in her the obligation of giving and she has continued in her mother's footsteps. As a teen in Oklahoma City, Helen began her lifelong relationship with the NCJW by joining the Junior Council of Jewish Women. Just two years ago Helen received the coveted Hannah G. Solomon Award "for leadership and services . . . for enhancing the role of women in community life and for motivating others."

Graduating Phi Beta Kappa in journalism from the University of Oklahoma, Helen worked in public

relations until marrying Leo, a Phi Beta Kappa graduate himself from the University of Minnesota Law School, where he was an editor of the Minnesota Law Review. They met during World War II when Leo was stationed in Oklahoma City as a Transportation Officer with the Air Corps. In 1946, after serving in India, Leo and Helen were married. They spent two years in Kalispell, Montana, where Leo and his uncle owned and operated a lumberyard, and then settled down in Minneapolis to raise a family and begin an involvement with the community that would only deepen throughout nearly 60 years.



A Life Together in Minneapolis

Leo became an insurance consultant, opening his own agency. In addition to providing life and casualty insurance, he developed the first plans in this area for union Teamsters groups — providing health, dental and vision coverage. He became a member of the million dollar round table of Northwestern National Life Insurance Company, and in 1977, was elected president of Oak Ridge Country Club.

Meanwhile, Helen's involvement in the NCJW "became my avenue to participation in both the Jewish and general communities — as a two-term president there were so many opportunities for involvement!" says Helen, who also served as a vice president of the Jewish Community Center.

Continuing The Spirit of Giving

The Wolks are particularly pleased that their children and grandchildren are perpetuating their belief in giving to the community with their own financial support and volunteer involvement. Joyce says, "Mom and Dad have big hearts and a true caring for others. Our parents have always helped family and friends in times of need. It means a great deal to them to know that others will greatly benefit from their support of the Sholom Foundation."

If you are age 70½ or older, you may now instruct the Trustee or Custodian of your IRA to directly transfer up to \$100,000 of your IRA to a qualified public charity like Sholom Foundation tax-free. PLUS, this gift from your IRA will count toward your Required Annual Distribution.

An Easy Way to Make a Gift to Sholom Foundation of ANY Amount From Your IRA:

up to \$100,000 and it will count toward all or part of your Required Annual Distribution.

Save Taxes on Lower Reportable

Income: a charitable gift made directly from your IRA to Sholom Foundation of part or all of your Required Annual Distribution, will lower your reportable income by the amount of the gift and can save you taxes.

Effectively Increase Your Giving

Limit: a charitable gift made directly from your IRA to Sholom Foundation permits you to give “over & above” the usual deductible amount of 50% of annual income — up to \$100,000 in 2006 and in 2007.

Lower Tax on Social Security:

a charitable gift made directly from

your IRA to Sholom Foundation may reduce the amount of your Social Security income that is taxable.

Standard Deduction Benefit: even if you do not itemize on your tax return, a charitable gift made directly from your IRA to Sholom Foundation will be excluded as income on your return, and therefore may reduce your taxes.

REMEMBER: Your IRA trustee or custodian must transfer your IRA gift directly to ‘Sholom Foundation,’ the Sholom entity that is accepting qualified IRA tax-free contributions under this new law. Your gift will be used for the purpose that you have designated. Be sure to consult your professional advisor to determine how this new provision may benefit both you and Sholom Foundation. For the Nouns, It Really IS All in the Family

We are fortunate people because of our children.

In talking with Joan and Norman Noun, the word “family” crops up in nearly every sentence. They have one-track minds; everything in their lives comes back to “family.”

Not that they are boring people ...or unsocial...or exclusive. They just know what is important to them. And the most important thing to Joan and Norman is their family. It always has been.

“We are fortunate people because of our children,” says Joan. “Not a day goes by that we don’t talk to them.” And that close-knit attitude has been passed down through the generations — from their children to their grandchildren.

Daughters Amie Noun (Ira Isbin), living in Edina, and Pam (Jim Ottenstein), living in Minnetonka, are on the phone with or visiting their parents several times a day. And daughter Heidi Noun (Mike Collins), an attorney living in Seattle, stays connected through calls and frequent trips.

That sensibility affected their business lives, too. Norman, who worked decades as a manufacturer’s representative in an eclectic array of consumer categories, eventually brought two of his daughters into the business, and one of them ultimately took it over.

The concept of family is one that both Norman and Joan grew up with – Norman in North Minneapolis, and Joan in Highland Park, St. Paul. “Our parents taught us everything – from our sense of family to our

sense of giving,” acknowledges Norman. While neither family was wealthy, “they lived by the rule that you gave everything you could.” As their families aged and needed care, the Nouns saw how the caregivers at Sholom treated their residents like family, and they were impressed. Norman’s father lived his last years at the old Sholom Residence on

Randolph, and Joan’s mother was cared for at Sholom East. In more recent years, Norman’s sister and brother-in-law both resided at Sholom West. “Everyone was given such wonderful care,” says Joan.

So it felt natural to Joan and Norman to begin giving back to those who gave their loved ones so much. Long time supporters of the Sholom Home Auxiliary and the Sholom Ball, last year, they also established the *Joan & Norman Noun Family Fund* with Sholom Foundation, and since then have been adding to it through regular donations honoring their friends and family. “It builds up pretty fast!” Norman adds enthusiastically.

While the Nouns have been regular donors to such organizations as Camp Teko, Hadassah, American Cancer Society, Pacer and St. Mary’s Hospital in Rochester, they admit that Sholom holds a special place in their hearts. “I can’t say enough about them!” exudes Joan.

It's Inventory Time

Remember the good old days when you would see a sign in a store window on December 31st that read, "CLOSING EARLY FOR INVENTORY." With modern computerized accounting systems, the stores still close early but the inventory process doesn't take as long.

The end of the year is also a good time for individuals to set aside a few hours for personal inventory. For those of you intent on "leaving your house in order," it is time to reassess your intentions and address the following questions:

- Does your will and living trust still accurately declare your intentions?
- Are these documents still accurate and not affected by anyone's death, divorce, change of residence or significant tax law changes?
- Are loved ones' needs being cared for appropriately, including children, grandchildren and even parents?
- Are there significant other people who need to be cared for with benefits?
- Are all the executors, trustees and guardians who have been nominated to assume major responsibilities still appropriate choices?
- Have the documents been properly executed?
- Have the appropriate people who will carry out your directives been notified, agreed to the responsibility, and know where to find the relevant documents?
- Is your Durable Power of Attorney still valid and does it still express your desires accurately?

- Is there an updated Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care on file?
- Has your "extended family" (i.e., charitable interests like Sholom Foundation) been included to receive a specified amount or percentage of your estate?

You Can Receive a Gift from Sholom Foundation

Receive Annual Payments for the Rest of Your Life. When you transfer stock or make a gift of cash to Sholom Foundation in exchange for a Charitable Gift Annuity, you will receive a guaranteed annual payout that, depending on your age, can be as high as 11.3 percent for the rest of your life. Plus, you will receive valuable tax benefits at the time of your contribution and on a portion of the annual payments you will receive.

The annuity can provide lifetime payments for yourself, or for both yourself and one other person. Or you may choose to direct that the gift annuity payments be made to an individual other than you or your spouse, such as a parent or adult child who will be in need of monthly income.

Defer receiving payments until a time of your choosing, and you will receive an even higher annuity rate. Plus, your initial income tax charitable deduction will be increased. Depending on your age and when your payments begin, your annual payout rate can be as high as 15% or more. This option is appealing to younger donors in their 50’s and 60’s who wish to improve future income when they retire, but also would like to support Sholom.

Upon your death, Sholom Foundation receives the remainder of the annuity. Your gift will continue to support the Sholom facilities and programs that serve our elderly loved ones.
